Addition is the mathematics of counting.
We use the plus symbol + for addition. We use the minus symbol - for subtraction.

B is for Base

$$2^3 = 8$$

A base number is the number being multiplied by an exponent.


C is for Chord



A chord is a straight line inside of a circle.

Chords are used in geometry and trigonometry. Each end of a **chord** touches the circle. If the **chord** passes through the center of the circle, it is called the **diameter**.

D is for Division



Division is the mathematics of fair sharing.

Division separates something into equal parts. The number being divided is the **dividend**. The number used to divide by is the **divisor**. **Division** is the inverse (opposite) of multiplication.


