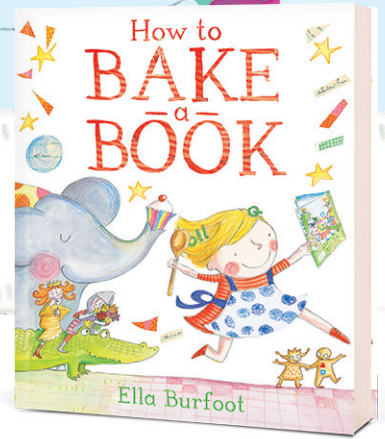

Draw a line from each picture to the word that best describes it!

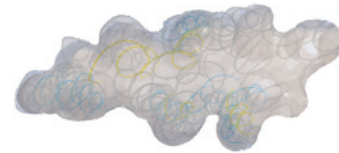

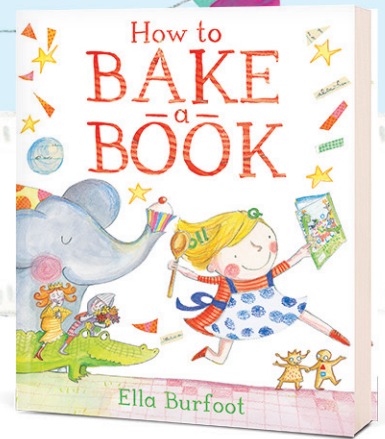

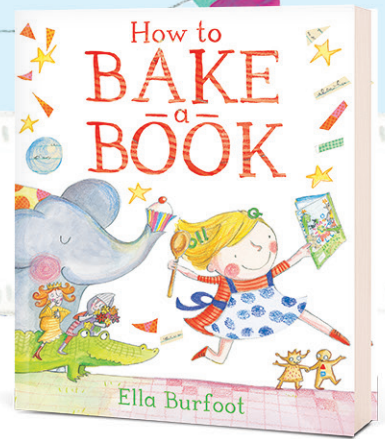


FIND THE CUTOUT CHARACTERS

The cutout characters from the story have wandered off. Help find all **ten** so she can finish baking her book!

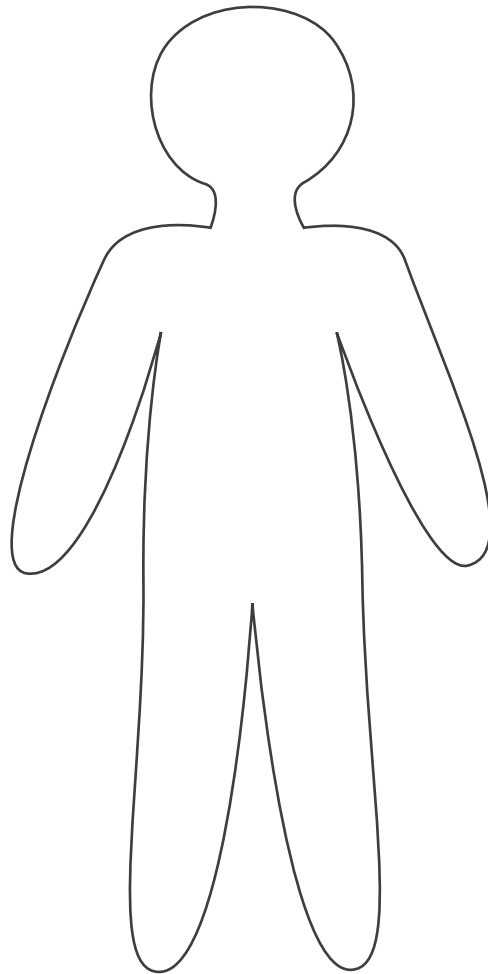

CREATE YOUR OWN CHARACTER

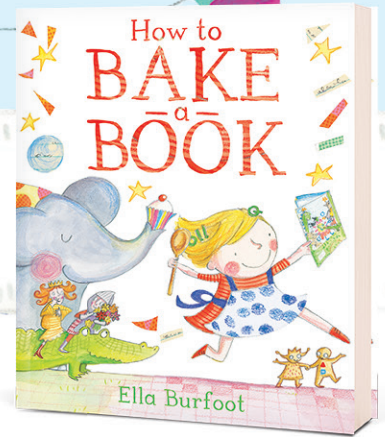
Imagine you're baking your very own book—now think about who your main character would be! Color in the outline below to show what the character looks like. And don't forget to give them a name!

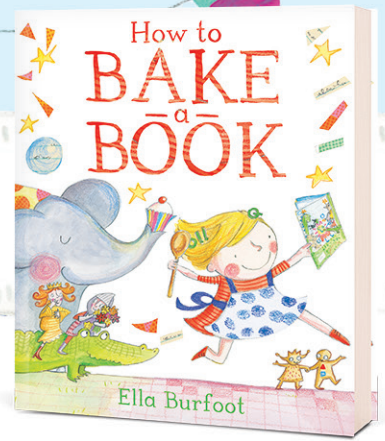
