

## **PAINT A MERMAID ROCK!**

## **SUPPLIES:**

- River rocks (rocks can be bought at craft stores, just make sure they are relatively flat)
- Acrylic paint (shades of blue, green, and turquoise work best)
- Small paintbrushes
- Fine-tip paint pens or metallic Sharpies
- Mod Podae

## **DIRECTIONS:**

Clean and dry the rocks.

Souce: www.projectswithkids.com Paint the rocks the desired color. We recommend you give each rock three coats of paint. Play with the paint and have fun! Make them two or three toned by painting each rock two or three

Let the rocks dry completely (overnight is best).

Use paint pens (silver, gold, or rose gold work well) or Sharpies to draw scales on your rock.

Once the paint or Sharpie scales are dry, cover your rock with a coat or two of Mod Podge so the paint won't rub off.
