## Create your own elf trap!

#### **GIFT BOX TRAP**

#### YOU'LL NEED:

- · An empty tissue box
- · Wrapping paper or construction paper
- · Tape
- · Scissors

- · Markers or holiday stickers
- · A craft stick
- · Candy, cookies, hand-drawn cookies, or colorful pom poms

Wrap your tissue box like it's a present using wrapping paper or construction paper. Cut a hole out of the paper where the hole is in the box. Decorate the box using markers, stickers or anything else you think would attract an elf! Prop the box up by using the craft stick (you might need to cut it in half). Lure the elf in by leaving a trail of sweets to the box! Wait for the morning to see if you caught an elf!

#### **CANDY JAR**

#### YOU'LL NEED:

- · A glass jar
- · Wrapping paper or construction paper
- · Tape and glue
- · Scissors


- · Craft sticks
- · Candy, cookies, hand-drawn cookies, or colorful pom poms

Wrap the top of your jar in wrapping paper, leave the bottom of the jar un-wrapped so you can see the candy at the bottom. Using the craft sticks and glue, create a ladder to lean against the jar. Write a note that says "Holiday Candy" and tape it to the jar. Put sweet treats in the bottom of the jar and wait for your elf to fall in when he tries to get the sweets!


#### **ELF SNATCHER 3000**


## Create your own Pup and Dragon advent calendar!


#### Supplies:


- One 24-cup cupcake tin (or two l2-cup cupcake tins)

- Markers/colored pencils/ crayons


#### Instructions:


- · Print the Pup and Dragon advent calendar squares

- Every day in December, remove the tape from one of the squares and discover the prize inside!






