
Since when do the dead send emails?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

 Describe a time when you saw someone taken advantage of.

 Why do you think students perform Sacramenta?

 Can you describe a tradition from your own life that is important to you?
- Why do you think Kate decides to wear Grace's pearls?

 How do you think Grace would feel about the way her friend changed?
- How might things have been different if Maddie had died instead of Grace?

 How do you think the story would have changed?

 Would Kate have reacted in the same way?
- How do you feel about the Grace's last email to Kate?
 Who do you think it's from? Why?
- Kate's relationship with her parents is strained.

 Do you think things would have been different if her parents were more involved?

 Why don't you think her parents are more supportive?
- Bethany and Taylor are members of the popular crowd.

 How do you think they got there?

 Why do you think there are popular and unpopular people?

 Do cliques have to exist?
- Describe Kate's relationship with Bradley Farrow.

 Have you ever felt attracted to someone who was not a good person?
- At the end of the book, Kate declines Taylor's invitation to be a member of the Sisterhood but promises to seek justice for Grace.

 Do you think she'll be able to accomplish this? How?
