
LOST ISLAND

DISCUSSION GUIDE


ABOUT THE AUTHOR

- 5. What do you think about what happens to Maeve's character at the end? Do you think her punishment is just? Why or why not?
- 6. How does Simone's relationship with Maeve change throughout the duology? What do you think of where they stood at the end? Would you have come to the same decision as Simone?
- 7. Simone decides to live with Sebastian and Jemma permanently after they thwart Maeve's plans. Do you think she'll remain with them or that her urge to wander will strike again in the future? Why or why not?
- 8. What was your favorite part of the book and why?
