- 5. Chloe's mother accuses Hunter of killing Chloe. Why does she lash out at Hunter in such a public way? What do you think is her goal?
- 6. Hunter and Daniel were very close growing up but have drifted apart over the years. Do you think it is unusual to drift apart from a close friend once high school starts? How do the pressures of entering high school affect relationships?
- 7. Hunter is suspicious of anything Hannah has to say about Chloe's behavior on the night of homecoming. Do you understand why he doesn't fully trust Hannah?
- 8. Hunter forms an unlikely friendship with Mike Basher as they both try to figure out what happened to Chloe. Have you ever found yourself becoming friends with someone you didn't think you had anything in common with?
- 9. Hunter admires Ron as a teacher and a mentor but ends up being highly disappointed in his behavior. Have you ever been let down by someone you admire?
- 10. At the end of the book, Hunter learns what Chloe's parents knew about the events on the night of homecoming and the accident. Were you surprised to learn these things? Do you understand why they did the things they did? What would you have done in their shoes?
