- 1. The novel follows three teenagers—Alex, Dominick, and Rita—and their choices to stay or leave through a vertex. Discuss how their families differ in making the decision.
- 2. Anxiety and other mental health issues are a major theme in the story. Trace its depiction in the novel through Alex, her dad, the strange lady with the quote, and the effect of the holograms' warning.
- 3. Another theme throughout the novel is how science, religion, the media, family, and friends influence our decisions. How do you make important decisions?
- 4. Alex isn't sure how to spend her last months on Earth. What do you think matters most when the world is ending? How would you spend your time?
- 5. At what point in the story would you have left through a vertex? Why?
- 6. If you were traveling through a vertex, what would you bring in your backpack?
- 7. Discuss the complex sibling relationship between Alex and Benji. Why do you think their relationship is antagonistic?
- 8. Why do you think Alex feels responsible to monitor her father's behavior? Do you think Alex's mother is fully aware of the situation, or avoiding it?
- 9. Debate: Should prisoners get the choice to leave through a vertex? Why or why not?
- 10. Debate: Should people have to pay off all debt before leaving through a vertex? Why or why not?
- 11. The novel begins and ends at the same vertex location. How has Alex changed?
