DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

2. How would you describe the relationship both guys have to Professor Tuttle? What role does he play for the story?

3. Both Alden and Conrad face family pressures, but how do these pressures differ for each?

4. Both main characters have faced great disappointment in the year prior to their road trip. How have these disappointments shaped them as people? Have you experienced any similar setbacks?

5. The two have vastly different play styles for the card game played throughout the book. How do their play styles reflect who they are as people? Do their play styles evolve and change over the course of the book?

6. Gaming, conventions, and fandom all play big roles in the book. Have you played table top games before? Why do you think gaming, particularly this particular card game, are so important to each hero?

7. Who emerges as the biggest "winner" of the book? Why?

8. Who changes the most over the course of the book? Why? How does the road trip itself influence this growth?

9. Which was your favorite of the various stops along their road trip? How did the different stops influence their feelings toward each other?

10. How do you view the progression of Alden and Conrad's feelings toward each other? How have things changed as the story ends and where do you think they go from here as a couple?
